The section of the proposed scheme closest to the monument would be constructed on-line with widening to the east and a new access link (Broadway Street Link) constructed close to the western carriageway on the side closest to the church). While the main part of the proposed scheme will not be visible from the scheduled monument due to its position on the western side of the church, the proposed environmental mitigation works to create wet woodland and grassland mosaic along an existing field boundary approximately 600m north of the monument is likely to be visible. This would not alter any aspect of the monument's setting which contributes to its value. However, there is also a potentially perceptible increase in operational traffic noise, assessed by the noise assessment (Chapter 11 Noise and vibration) as a moderate adverse effect in the short term, diminishing to minor over time.
