


SMART SUSTAINABLE CITIES

Ahead of the 26th UN Climate Change Conference hosted by Glasgow in November 2021, this year's series aims to raise climate ambition and promote effective implementation of city-level decarbonisation projects in the areas of mobility, circular economy, resilience and nature-based solutions.

The Smart Sustainable Cities is a flagship project led by the British Embassy in Madrid, an FCDO initiative, funded by the Prosperity Fund. It brings together senior city experts and policymakers from selected European and UK cities to showcase best practice and provide a two-way opportunity for knowledge sharing and networking. The workshops will be conducted virtually, yet will aim to express the flavour and profile of the Host Cities. They will consist of engaging working sessions collaborating closely with other government departments such as the COP Unit and BEIS, creating a sense of community and begin a shared journey on the building up to COP26.
